## **How to Return to Camp**

### **Frequently Asked Questions**

#### Can I Ever Come Back To This Camp?

Yes, as a Cadet you may return to camp by becoming an Assistant Leader.

#### How Do I Become An Assistant Leader?

You **MUST** complete as many projects and activities as possible, record and submit them in a Book of Accomplishments (BOA) **AND** submit an Assistant Leader/College Scholarship Application by the deadline!

#### What Types of Projects Can I Do?

See the <u>Book of Accomplishments (BOA) Instructions & Activity Values Sheet</u> for the different types of projects you can complete. The most popular activities are giving presentations about Texas Brigades, setting up your poster or trifold around your community, making a plant or seed collection, and writing articles about camp to submit to newspapers and magazines. For every activity you complete you **MUST** complete a <u>Cadet Activity</u> Report Form.

#### **How Many Activities Should I Complete?**

As many as you possibly can!!! A limited number of Cadets will be allowed to return to camp as Assistant Leaders. The more projects you complete the greater your chances are for returning to camp and receiving a college scholarship.

#### **How Are Assistant Leaders Chosen?**

Camp graduates (Cadets) with the highest scoring Book of Accomplishments (BOA) are invited to return to camp. Scores for each activity are calculated by the quality of project/information submitted and a max-point system, which can be referenced in the <u>Book of Accomplishments (BOA) Instructions & Activity Values Sheet</u>. Activities must be completed before you submit your Book of Accomplishments. Points are not awarded for activities completed after the deadline.

# Where can I find the <u>Book of Accomplishments (BOA) Instructions & Activity Values Sheet</u> and <u>Cadet Activity Report Form?</u>

All the forms and instructions you need to complete a Book of Accomplishments can be found on the Texas Brigades website **www.texasbrigades.org**. Select the "Resources" tab at the top of the website. Forms and instructions will also be available in your Cadet Binder or Notebook, on your post-camp Google Drive link, and/or on your Cadet post-camp flash drive.

#### **Can I Attend A Different Texas Brigades Camp?**

YES! You may apply to each of the six types of Brigade camps: Bobwhite, Buckskin, Bass, Waterfowl, Coastal, and Ranch once as a Cadet. To serve as many Cadets as possible, it is rare to attend both of the Buckskin or both Bobwhite camps offered.
